




# Design For '09

What is one of the most exciting design elements in 2009? Green design and sustainable products! Bamboo flooring has long been available, but it used to come in only a few finishes. Now there are many finishes that range from natural bamboo to rich, dark tones. You would never expect that it was bamboo, and it's more cost efficient and durable than real wood.
